

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2012-17

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HAMILTON TO AMEND THE HAMILTON ALCOHOL ORDINANCE
TO SPECIFY THE SPECIFIC NOTICE PROVISIONS OF
SAID ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, as follows:

SECTION I. AMENDMENT. That the Hamilton Alcohol Ordinance be and hereby is amended to read as follows:


SECTION.1-75. Public notice.

(b) All applicants seeking consent and approval for a License shall certify to the City that notice of the application, said notice stating the day and time it is to be heard and considered at said public hearing by the City, has been circulated to all residents, real property owners and businesses located within 500 feet of the property sought to be licensed, by leaving a copy of said notice with each such resident, real property owner or business or with some Person over 18 years of age at the home of such resident, real property owner or at each business, or, in the case of a real property owner, by certified mail to the address of the real property owner listed on record with the Marion County Revenue Commissioner's Office, at least one week before the public meeting at which it is expected to be heard and considered by the City.

SECTION II. INCLUSION. Other than as provided in Section 1 of this amendment, the Hamilton Alcohol Ordinance of the City of Hamilton is adopted, realleged and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.



Each and every provision of this ordinance is hereby declared to be an independent provision, and the holding of any provision hereof to be void or invalid, shall not affect any other provision hereof, and it is hereby declared that the other provisions of this ordinance would have been enacted regardless of any provision which might be held invalid.
