

TO REGULATE, DIRECT AND CONTROL THE KEEPING OF PENS, BARN, SHEDS, LOTS OR ENCLOSURES IN WHICH COWS, HOGS, PIGS, HORSES, MULES OR ANIMALS OR LIKE KIND, ARE KEPT WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA, AND TO REQUIRE A PERMIT THEREFOR, WHICH MAY BE DENIED OR REVOKED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The word "animal" or "animals" as used herein, shall include and refer to pigs, cows, mules, calves, hogs, horses, ponies or animals of like kind.

Section 2. The word "enclosure" shall include and refer to pens, barns, sheds, lots, acreage, enclosures or other places where an animal or animals are kept within the corporate limits of the City of Hamilton, Alabama.

Section 3. The words "each offense" as used herein shall mean each day or part thereof that a person violates, by commission or omission, any provision of this ordinance.

Section 4. The word "person" as used herein shall mean any person, firm, or corporation, owning or having in possession any animal or animals within an enclosure as defined herein.

Section 5. The word "permit" as used herein shall mean any written authority granted by the Mayor of the City of Hamilton, standing unrevoked, and shall refer to or include only the enclosure designated therein.

Section 6. The word "house" as used herein, shall mean any building, where one or more persons work, sleep, eat, or reside, all or any portion of the day.

Section 7. It shall be and it is hereby made unlawful for any person to keep any animal or animals in an enclosure without first obtaining a permit from the Mayor of the City of Hamilton, to do so.

Section 8. No permit shall be granted, and it shall be the duty of the Mayor or revoke same if it has been granted, authorizing any person to keep an animal or animals in an enclosure as herein defined, when in the judgment of the Mayor, the keeping of such an animal will endanger or impair the health of all or any of the inhabitants of the City of Hamilton, and it shall not be necessary for such Mayor, in making such revocation, to assign, except upon order of Court, any reason for such revocation. It shall be mandatory for the Mayor to revoke a permit that has been granted if the person to whom the same has been granted, fails to obey strictly, any and all the regulations herein applicable to the keeping of such animal or animals within enclosure. He may revoke the permit for such other causes or reasons that are conducive to preserving or protecting the health of any or all inhabitants of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, who reside within the corporate limits of said City.

Section 9. When and if said permit is revoked it shall become immediately unlawful for any person, after written notice served upon such person that said permit has been revoked, to keep said animal or animals within an enclosure.

Section 10. No pig or hog shall be kept within an enclosure unless the same has more than 250 square feet to each hog or pig so penned, where there is no flooring. There shall be no hog or pig kept on floored pen. If any foul or offensive odor emanates from said enclosure, said pig or hog shall be removed therefrom.

Section 11. No cow or calves shall be kept in any enclosure unless the same has 100 square feet to each cow or calf enclosed.

Section 12. No mules or horses shall be kept in any enclosure unless the same has 100 square feet to each horse or mule enclosed.

Section 13. Pigs or hogs shall not be kept in any enclosure within 150 feet of any house.

Section 14. Cows or calves shall not be kept within 25 feet of any house.


Section 15. It shall be the duty of each person as herein defined to remove or cause to be removed daily the excreta deposited by said animal in said enclosure where the same is less than 500 feet. The removal shall be to some place off the premises of said enclosure and shall be piled or collected in the open air where the sun may shine thereon.

Section 16. If said enclosure, or the excreta thereon or taken therefrom, gives off any foul or offensive odor, the Mayor shall forthwith revoke said permit and it shall then become the duty of such person, whose permit has been revoked, to remove said animal or animals from said enclosure immediately upon receiving written notice of such revocation.


Section 17. It shall be unlawful for any person as defined herein to keep any animal or animals in an enclosure, as defined herein, without obtaining from the Mayor a permit therefor; or keep the same if such permit has been revoked and such person has received notice in writing of such revocation.

Section 18. The violation by such commission or omission, or any provision or section of this ordinance, shall constitute an offense, and for each offense, any person adjudged to be guilty shall be fined not less than \$1.00 and not more than \$100.00 and may in addition, be sentenced to hard labor upon the streets of the City of Hamilton for not more than three months.

ORDINANCE NO. 409

To regulate, direct and control the keeping of pens, barns, sheds, lots or enclosure in which cows, hogs, pigs, horses, mules or animals or like kind, are kept within the

ORDINANCE NO. 409

To regulate, direct and control the keeping of pens, barns, sheds, lots or enclosure in which cows, hogs, pigs, horses, mules or animals or like kind, are kept within the corporate limits of the city of Hamilton, Alabama, and of require a permit therefor, which may be denied or revoked.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, as follows:


