A tract of land situated in the NW ¼ of NE ¼ and in the NE ¼ of NW ¼ of Section 4, Township 11 South, Range 13 West, Marion County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows, to-wit: "Beginning at the SW Corner of said NW ¼ of NE ¼, which said corner is a two-inch iron pipe; thence run North 86 degrees 25' West, along the South boundary of said NE ¼ of NW ¼, a distance of 210.00 feet to a steel post; thence North 01 degrees 30' West, making an interior angle of 95 degrees 05 minutes, and running parallel with the East boundary of said NE ¼ of NW ¼, a distance of 420.00 feet to a steel post; thence South 86 degrees 25' East, making an interior angle of 84 degrees 55', and running parallel with the South boundary of said NE ¼ of NW ¼ a distance of 210.00 feet to a point on the West boundary of said NW ¼ of NE ¼; thence run North 01 degrees 30' West, along the West boundary of said NW ¼ of NE ¼, a distance of 378.61 feet to a steel post; thence South 80 degrees 51' East, making an interior angle of 79 degrees 21', and running parallel with the South right-of-way of U.S. Highway Number 278, a distance of 210.00 feet to a steel post; thence North 01 degrees 30' West, parallel with the West boundary of said NW ¼ of NE ¼, a distance of 420.00 feet to a steel post situated on the South right-of-way of said U.S. Highway Number 278; thence South 80 degrees 51' East, making an interior angle of 79 degrees 21', and running along the South right-of-way of said U.S. Highway Number 278, a distance of 291.62 feet to a steel post; thence South 01 degrees 30' East, making an interior angle of 100 degrees 39', and running parallel with the West boundary of said NW ¼ of NE ¼, a distance of 1,170.59 feet to a steel post situated on the South boundary of said NW ¼ of NE ¼; thence North 86 degrees 19' West, making an interior angle of 84 degrees 49', and running along the South boundary of said NW ¼ of NE ¼, a distance of 495.00 feet to the point of beginning of the land herein described."
