ORDINANCE NO. 385

Be it ordained by the city Council of Hamilton, Alabama, as follows:

That the following described lands be and the same are hereby annexed to and are a part of and within the corporate limits of the City of Hamilton, Alabama:

The $\frac{W}{4}$ of $\frac{SW}{4}$ of Section 4, and all that part of the $\frac{E}{4}$ of $\frac{SE}{4}$ of Section 5 that lies South of Alabama Highway No. 17; the $\frac{NE}{4}$ of Section 8; and the $\frac{W}{4}$ of $\frac{NW}{4}$ of Section 9; all in Township 11 South, Range 14 West, Marion County, Alabama.

On a vote on the motion to suspend the rules for immediate consideration and passage of the ordinance, those voting "yea" were: E. T. Sims, Jr., Mayor; and, Walter Nancy, Victor Cranford, Floyd Long, Bobby Loden and Norman Holloway, Councilmen. Those voting "Nay" none.

Councilman Floyd Long then moved for the adoption of said ordinance and this motion was seconded by Councilman Bobby Loden.

Upon a vote being taken, those voting in favor of the adoption of said ordinance were E. T. Sims, Jr., Mayor; and, Walter Nancy, Victor Cranford, Floyd Long, Bobby Loden and Norman Holloway, Councilmen. Those voting against none.

The Mayor then announced that said ordinance had been duly and legally adopted.


