A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, was held at the City Hall in Hamilton, Alabama, at

7:00 P. M. on Monday, April 11, 1977.

Mayor E. T. Sims, Jr., presided over the meeting and upon a roll call, the following were present: E. T. Sims, Jr., Mayor, and Lowell D. Cantrell,

Larry W. Davis, Robert L. Loden,

Tommy H. Fikes, John L. Suck,

Councilmen. Absent: None.

The Mayor then announced that a quorum was present and that the meeting was open for business.

The Mayor announced that the City of Hamilton had received a petition from more than 60% of the present property owners of the following described land, to-wit:

Being all the North $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 31, Township 10 South, Range 13 West and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, Township 10 South, Range 13 West and all of Section 32 that lies Southwest of Buttahatchee River and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ that lies Southwest of Buttahatchee in Section 33, Township 10 South, Range 13 West and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30 and all that part of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 19 that lies South of 43 Highway all being in Township 10 South, Range 13 West, and all that part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ that lies South of U. 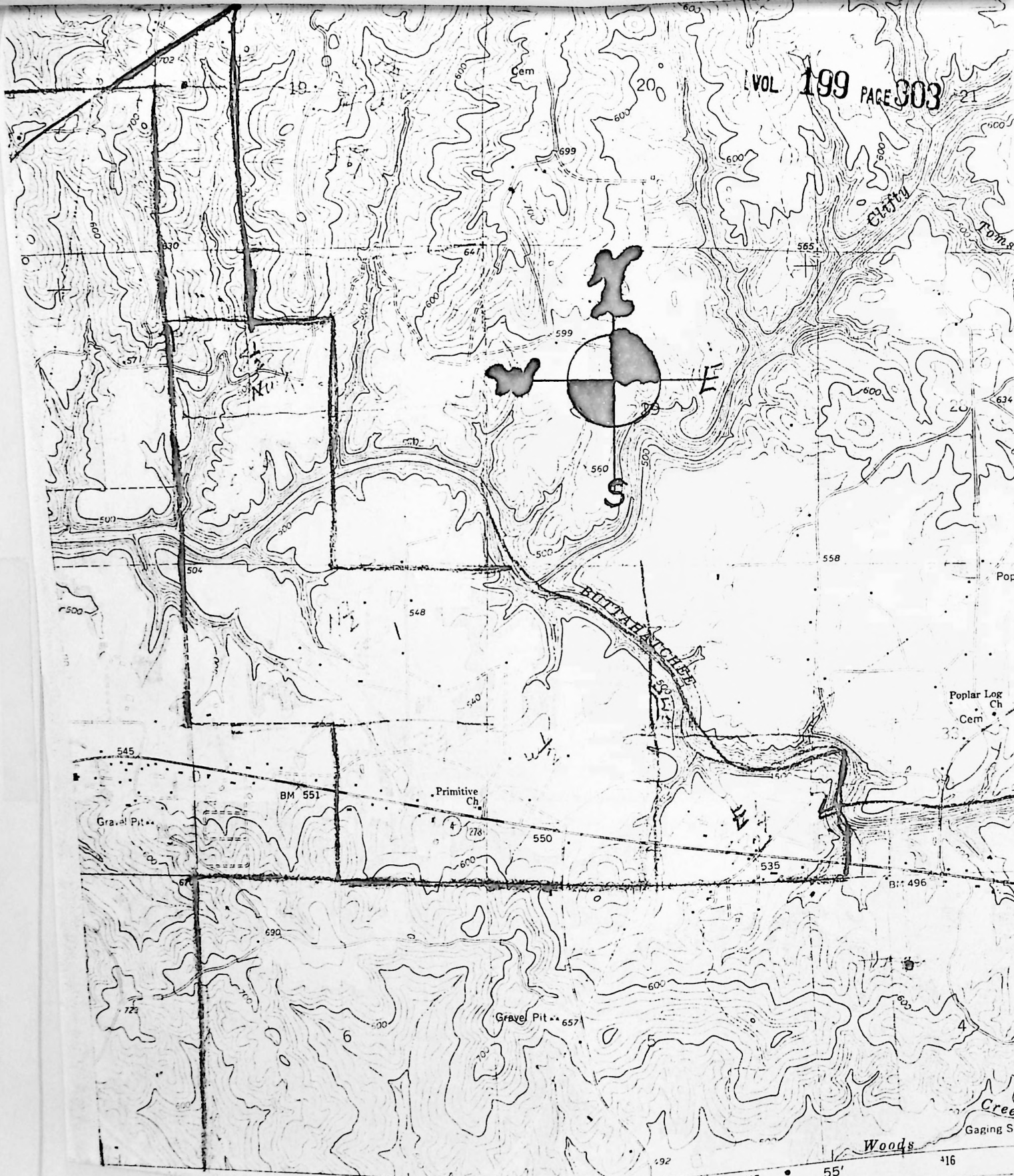
