

ORDINANCE NO. 398-A

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hamilton, Alabama that the governing body of said City does hereby assent to the annexation of the following described property to the City of Hamilton, Alabama:

TRACT 1

NE $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 32, Township 10 South, Range 14 West, Marion County, Alabama.

TRACT 2

A tract of land situated in the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 32, Township 10 South, Range 14 West, Marion County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows, to-wit: "Beginning at the Southwest corner of the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 32; thence North along the West boundary of said SE $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{2}$ a distance of 570 feet to an iron pin situated on the South right-of-way of a Marion County paved road (Old Eastport Road); thence Southeasterly along the South right-of-way of said Marion County paved road (Old Eastport Road) a distance of 1,400 feet to an iron pin situated at the intersection of the South right-of-way of said Marion County paved road (Old Eastport Road) and the East boundary of said SE $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{2}$; thence South along the East boundary of said SE $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{2}$ a distance of 174 feet to the Southeast corner of said SE $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{2}$; thence West along the South boundary of said SE $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{2}$ a distance of 1,332 feet to the point of beginning of the land herein described.";

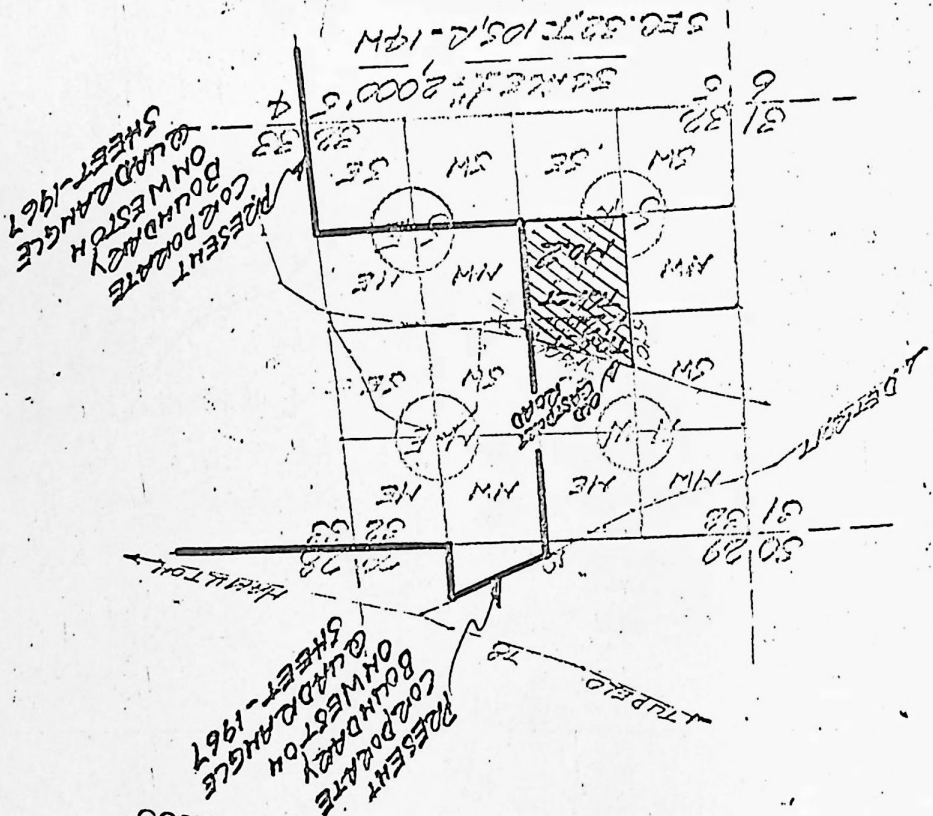

Hamilton, Alabama.

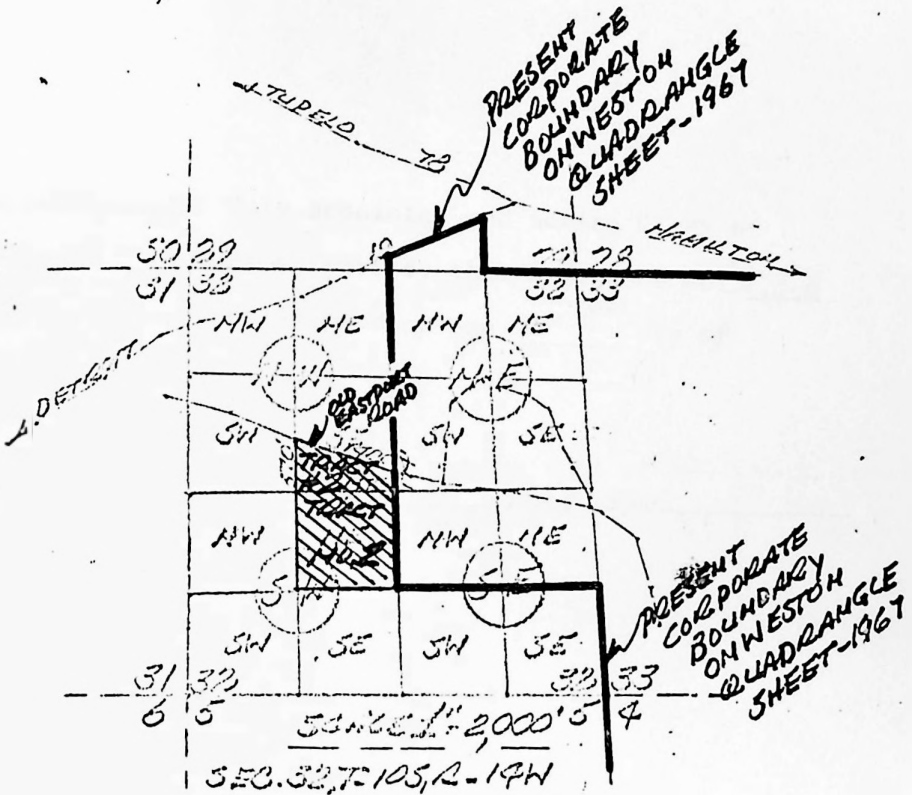
