BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, that the public health or public good requires that certain territory, to-wit:

Lying and being in NW<sup>1</sup><sub>2</sub> of Section 19, Township 10 South, Range 13 West, and the NE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> and the SE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> of NW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> of Section 24, Township 10 South, Range 14 West, Marion County, Alabama, and being more particularly described as follows:

Begin at a point where the center of New U.S. Highway 43 intersects the east boundary of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19, Township 10 South, Range 13 West; thence run north, along the east boundary of NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, to the northeast corner of NE% of NW%; thence run west, along the north boundary of NW14 of Section 19 and the north boundary of NE% of Section 24 to the northwest corner of NE% of NE% of Section 24; thence run south, along the west boundary of the NE% of NE%, to the southwest corner of NE% of NE%, thence run west along the south boundary of NW4 of NE4 and the NE4 of NW4 to the southwest corner of NE4 of NW4; thence run south along the west boundary of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  to the southwest corner of the SE4 of SW4; thence run east along the south boundary of SE4 of NW4 and the NE4 to where said south boundary of NE4 intersects the center of new U. S. Highway 43; thence run in a northeasterly direction, approximate bearing being north 55° east, along the centerline of new U. S. Highway 43, to where U. S. Highway 43 intersects the east boundary of NE4 of NW4 of Section 19, Township 10 South, Range 13 West, and the point of beginning.
