ORDINANCE NO. 436

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hamilton, Alabama that the governing body of said City does hereby assent to the annexation of the following described property to the City of Hamilton, Alabama:

> A tract of land containing 6 acres, more or less, situated in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 10 South, Range 13 West, Marion County, Alabama more particularly described as follows, to-wit: "Beginning at the intersection of the road with the North boundary of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence South along the West side of said road a distance of 300 yards; thence West parallel with the North boundary of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 100 yards; thence North parallel with the west side of said road a distance of 300 yards to the North boundary of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 100 yards to the point of beginning of the lands herein described.",

and that a certified copy of this ordinance and attached thereto a plat or map of said property be delivered by Murray C. Ballard, Mayor to Honorable Annette Bozeman, Judge of ^{Probate} of Marion County, Alabama.
