ORDINANCE NO. 442


BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, that the governing body of said City does hereby assent to the annexation of the following described property to the City of Hamilton, Alabama:

All that part of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, Township 11 South, Range 13 West, Marion County, that lies North of the Old gravel road, containing 30 acres, more or less.

and that a certified copy of this ordinance and attached thereto a plat or map of said property be delivered by E. T. Sims, Jr., Mayor to Honorable Annette Bozeman, Judge of Probate of Marion County, Alabama.
