

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, that the following described lands be annexed into the city limits of the City of Hamilton, Alabama:

Beginning at a point 8 rods South of the Northeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 10 South, Range 15 West; thence run Northwest 26 rods to a branch; thence up said branch Northerly to the South right-of-way of Old U.S. Highway No. 78; thence run Easterly along said South right-of-way to a point that is 28 rods Northwest of the Southeast corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 10 South, Range 14 West, measuring along said South right-of-way; thence run Southwest to where said South right-of-way intersects the South boundary of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence run West, along the South boundary of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, to a point 28 rods East of the Southwest corner of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence run Southwesterly to a point 28 rods South of the Northwest corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 10 South, Range 14 West; thence run North, along the West boundary of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, to the point of beginning, and containing 10 acres, more or less; all the above described lands being situated in Marion County, Alabama.

All that part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 10 South, Range 14 West, Marion County, Alabama, that lies North of the Old Bankhead Highway.

Beginning at a point that is 660 feet South of and 438 feet west of the NW corner of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, Township 10 South, Range 15 West; thence South 06 degrees 00 minutes West a distance of 195 feet to the North right-of-way line of the Old U. S. Highway # 78; thence North 83 degrees 00 minutes East and along said right-of-way line 308 feet to a concrete right-of-way marker; thence north 06 degrees 00 minutes east a distance of 220 feet; thence South 86 degrees 00 minutes east a distance of 300 feet to the point of beginning, containg 1.4 acres, more or less, lying and being situated in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 10 South, Range 15 West.

A tract of land containing 0.56 acre, more or less, situated in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 10 South, Range 14 West, Marion County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows, to-wit: "Beginning at the Southwest corner of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, which said corner is an old rock corner and a car axle corner; thence run North 04 degrees 23 minutes West, along the West boundary of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and along a wire fence, a distance of 303.2 feet to an iron pin; thence run Southeasterly, parallel with the South right-of-way of Old U. S. Highway No. 78 (now Marion County Highway No. 94), a distance of 105 feet to an iron pin; thence run South 04 degrees 23 minutes East, parallel with the West boundary of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, a distance of 252.38 feet to an iron pin located on the South boundary of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence run South 88 degrees 59 minutes West, along the South boundary of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, a distance of 89.02 feet to the point of beginning of the land herein described."

The following described lands, to-wit: Beginning at the Northeast corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and run South along the East boundary of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 533 feet to an iron pin; thence run Westerly a distance of 500 feet to an iron pin located on the East side of the hold road; thence run Northeasterly along said old road a distance of 533 feet to an iron pin located at the intersection of said old road with the North boundary of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence run East along the North boundary of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 195 feet to the point of beginning, situated in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 10 South, Range 14 West, Marion County, Alabama, containing 4 acres, more or less.

All that tract of land lying south of Bankhead Highway (Old U. S. Highway No. 78) in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 10 South, Range 14 West, Marion County, Alabama LESS AND EXCEPT Beginning at the Southwest corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 10 South, Range 14 West, Marion County, Alabama; thence run N. 04 degrees 23 minutes W. along the westerly boundary of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ =NE $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 723.39 feet to its intersection with southerly right-of-way of Old U. S. Highway Number 78 (now county highway NO. 94); thence run S. 62 degrees 20 minutes E. along the southerly right-of-way of said highway a distance of 105.0 feet to an iron pin set; thence run S. 04 degrees 23 minutes E. and parallel with the westerly boundary of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 669.56 feet to an iron pin set on the southerly boundary of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ =NE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence run S. 86 degrees 50 minutes W. along the southerly boundary of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ =NE $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 89.02 feet to the point of beginning. Containing in the aggregate 1.42 acres.

Beginning at the NE corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, thence South and along the West boundary line of said forty a distance of 300 feet; thence East and parallel with North boundary line of said forty a distance of 814 feet more or less and to a point located on the West right-of-way line of State Highway # 19, thence Northerly and along said right-of-way line a distance of 304 feet more or less and to a point where said right-of-way line intersects with the North boundary line of said forty, thence West and along said North boundary a distance of 784 ft. more or less and to the point of beginning and containing 5.5 acres more or less, lying in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, Township 10 South, Range 15 West, Marion County, Alabama.

S. Highway No. 78; thence North 83 degrees 00 minutes East and along said right-of-way line 308 feet to a concrete right-of-way marker; thence north 06 degrees 00 minutes East a distance of 220 feet; thence South 86 degrees 00 minutes East a distance of 300 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.4 acres, more or less, lying and being situated in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, Township 10 South, Range 15 West

The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 10 South, Range 15 West, Marion County, Alabama.

To begin at the southwest corner of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 10 South Range 15 West, at the road leading to Vina, thence a northerly direction along said road to tile at head of ditch, thence a southeasterly direction along said ditch, the ditch the line to the well, said well being 250 feet north of the South line of said 20 acres, thence due east to the section line on the East, thence South along said Section line 250 feet to the southeast corner of said 20 acres, thence along south line of said 20 acres West to the point of beginning, containing 8 acres, more or less; also one-fourth of an acre, more or less, said parcel of land being in a V-shape and lying north of the Vina Road, West of the Palmer graveyard road and bound on the north by the north forty line and being about midway of the forty on the north side.

S. Highway No. 78); thence run South 14 degrees 56 minutes West a distance of 152.23 feet to an iron pin located on the flare of the intersection of said highways (Alabama Highway No. 19 and Marion County Highway No. 94), which said iron pin is located in the center of an old settlement road (now abandoned), and which said iron pin is the point of beginning of the land herein described; thence run Southerly, along said old settlement road, as follows: South 13 degrees 40 minutes West a distance of 236.85 feet, South 06 degrees 10 minutes West a distance of 116.55 feet, South 10 degrees 16 minutes East a distance of 237.70 feet, South 03 degrees 42 minutes West a distance of 86.91 feet, South 04 degrees 24 minutes East a distance of 205.28 feet to an iron pin, and South 10 degrees 49 minutes West a distance of 164.43 feet to an iron pin located on the West bank of Brown Creek (also known as Manscill and Jagers Creek), which said iron pin is also located at the point the Old Eastport Road (now abandoned) crosses said creek, and which said iron pin is also the common corner of Guy Fikes, Freemon Nixon, and the grantees herein; thence run East, along the Freemon Nixon wire fence (which is located in the center of said Old Eastport Road) to the West right-of-way of Alabama Highway No. 19; thence run Northerly, along the West right-of-way of said Alabama Highway No. 19, to a

concrete right-of-way marker located 20.0 feet South 54 degrees 50 minutes East of the point of beginning of the land herein described; thence run North 54 degrees 50 minutes West a distance of 20.0 feet to the point of beginning of the land herein described."

Beginning at an iron pin 35 feet West of the northeast corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, Township 10 South, Range 15 West said iron pin being located on the West right-of-way line of State Highway No. 19; thence South 2 degrees East and along said right-of-way line a distance of 315 feet and to an iron pin; thence West and parallel with North boundary of said forty a distance of 1107 feet; thence North and parallel with West boundary of said forty a distance of 315 feet and to an iron pin located on the North boundary line of said forty; thence East and along the North boundary line of said forty a distance of 1105 feet and to the point of beginning and containing 8 acres, more or less, lying in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, Township 10 South, Range 15 West, Marion County, Alabama.

The Western part of Tract 7 of the L. R. Fikes Estate Subdivision, according to the map or plat of same as recorded in Map Book 2 at Page 10, in the Probate office of Marion County, Alabama, being more particularly described as follows, to-wit: "Beginning at the Southwest corner of said Tract 7; thence run east along the south boundary of Tract 7 a distance of 310 feet to an iron pin; thence run Northerly a distance of 435 feet to an iron pin located on the southerly right-of-way of New U. S. Highway No. 78 and on the Northerly boundary of said Tract 7, at a point 125 feet Easterly of the Northwest corner of said Tract 7, said distance being measured along the Southerly right-of-way of said highway; thence run Northwesterly along said Southerly right-of-way a distance of 125 feet to the Northwest corner of said Tract 7; thence run south along the west boundary of said Tract 7 a distance of 570 feet to the point of beginning of the lands herein described." All of Tract 7 of the L. R. Fikes estate subdivision is hereby annexed into the city limits of the City of Hamilton.

Begin at the intersection of the West Line $SE\frac{1}{4}$ and West Line of Highway 19; thence S 740' (s) to North Line of U. S. Highway 78, SEly 355' (s) to West Line of Highway 19, thence NEly 75' (s), NWly 850' (s), to Point of Beginning IN $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 10, Range 14 West.

All $n\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ East of Highway 19 in Section 24, Township 10 South, Range 15 West. Tract 5 of the L. R. Fikes Estate Subdivision. Tract 8 of the L. R. Fikes Estate Subdivision.
