

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, that the following described property be annexed into the city limits of the City of Hamilton, Alabama:

All North and West of Cotton Gin Road, the road the line in $w\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Township 11 South, Range 14 West, containing 15 acres, more or less.

All South and East of Cotton Gin Road and North of Fulton Bridge Road in $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Township 11 South, Range 14 West, containing 47 acres more or less, lying and being situated in Marion County, Alabama.

The $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ in Section 8, Township 11 South, Range 14 West. Forty Acres, more or less, Marion County, Alabama.

The $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Township 11 South, Range 14 West, Marion County, Alabama.

A tract of land containing 34.24 acres, more or less, situated in the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ and in the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Township 11 South, Range 14 West; Marion County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Commence at the Southeast corner of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 8; thence run North 01 degree 59 minutes West, along the East boundary of said $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$, a distance of 330.0 feet to a steel post, which said steel post is the point of beginning of the land herein described; thence continue North 01 degree 59 minutes West, along the East boundary of said $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$, a distance of 983.60 feet to the Northeast corner of said $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$, thence run South 88 degrees 30 minutes West, along the North boundary of said $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ and along the North boundary of the said $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$, a distance of 2,545.43 feet to the intersection of the North boundary of said $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ with the Northeasterly right-of-way of Marion County Highway No. 11; thence run South 69 degrees 05 minutes East, along the Northeasterly right-of-way of said Marion County Highway No. 11, a distance of 485.41 feet to a concrete monument; thence run South 73 degrees 00 minutes East, continuing along the Northeasterly right-of-way of said Marion County Highway No. 11, a distance of 440.14 feet to a concrete monument, which said monument is the point of curvature of a curve to the right; thence run Southeasterly, continuing along the Northeasterly right-of-way of said Marion County Highway No. 11 and along the arc of said curve to the right (radius=1,343.24 feet, central angle = 27 degrees 29 minutes) a distance of 644.46 feet to a concrete monument; thence run South 57 degrees 45 minutes East, continuing along the Northeasterly right-of-way of said Marion County Highway No. 11, a distance of 295.15 feet to a concrete monument; thence run South 36 degrees 54 minutes East, continuing along the Northeasterly right-of-way of said highway, a distance of 144.80 feet to a steel post; thence run North 88 degrees 30 minutes East, parallel with the South boundary of said $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$, a distance of 843.05 feet to the point of beginning of the land herein described.

A tract of land containing one (1) acre, more or less, including that part now occupied by the paved road, situated in the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 11 South, Range 13 West, Marion County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a railroad spike set where a paved road intersects a small branch, said railroad spike lying approximately 400 feet South of and 200 feet East of the Northwest corner of said $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$; thence run South 02 degrees 41 minutes West a distance of 139 feet to a railroad spike set; thence run South 19 degrees 00 minutes East a distance of 250 feet to a railroad spike set and the point of beginning of the land herein described; thence run South 31 degrees 30 minutes West a distance of 50 feet to a point; thence run South 52 degrees 30 minutes West a distance of 50 feet to a point; thence run South 36 degrees 30 minutes West a distance of 50 feet to a point; thence run South 30 degrees 30 minutes West a distance of 50 feet to a point; thence run South 23 degrees 00 minutes West a distance of 150 feet to a point; thence run South 53 degrees 36 minutes East a distance of 126 feet to a point, said point being approximately 31 feet East of the center of a paved road; thence run with meander in a northeasterly and Northerly direction, adjacent to a paved road, a distance of approximately 412 feet to a point approximately 31 feet East of the center of the paved road; thence run South 80 degrees 30 minutes West a distance of 31 feet to the center of the paved road; thence run South 31 degrees 30 minutes West a distance of 9 feet to a railroad spike, the point of beginning of the land herein described.

and that a copy of this ordinance and a plat of said lands be delivered by E. T. Sama, Jr., Mayor, to Honorable Annette Bozeman, Judge of Probate, Marion County, Alabama.
