## ORDINANCE 98001

WHEREAS, on the llth day of March, 1998, John Leaburn Wilmone and Carolyn Sue Wilemon, being the owners of all the real property hereinafter described, did file with the City Clerk a petition asking that the said tracts or parcels of land be annexed to and become a part of the city of Hamilton; and

WHEREAS, said petition did contain the signatures of the owners of the described territory and a map of said property showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the city of Hamilton; and

WHEREAS, the governing body did determine that it is in the public interest that said property be annexed to the city of Hamilton and it did further determine that all legal requirements for annexing said real property have been meet pursuant to Sections 11-42-20 through 11-42-24, code of Alabama, 1975;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Sectionl. The council of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, finds and declares as the legislative body of the City that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City, and the citizens of the affected area, to bring the territory described in Section 2 of this ordinance into the City of Hamilton.

Section 2. The boundary lines of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, be, and the same are hereby altered or rearranged so as to include all of the territory hereto before encompassed by the corporate limits of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, and in addition thereto the following described territory, to-wit:

An irregular-shaped tract of land, containing 2.4 acres, more or less, lying in the wl/2 of SEl/4 of NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 22, Twonship 11 South, Range 14 west, Marion County, alabama being more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at existing concrete post, the southwest corner of SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 22, Township 11 South, Range 14 West: thence run south 87 degrees 42' east, along the south boundary of SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, a distance of 216 feet to iron pin set on the south boundary of said forty; thence run north 14 degrees 09' west a distance of 207 feet to iron pin set; thence run north 12 degrees 47' east a distance of 96 feet to iron pin set; thence run north 20 degrees 32'east a distance of 178 feet to iron pin set thence run north 6 degrees 18' east a distance of 111.9 feet to iron pin; thence run in a southwesterly direction, along south side of a paved road, a distance of 326 feet to existing concrete post, said concrete post being located on the west boundary of Se<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>; thence run south 1 degree 11'east, along the west boundary of said forty, and existing fence line, a distance of 394 feet to the southwest corner of said forty and the point of beginning of the land herein described.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published as provided by law, and a certified copy of same, together with a certified copy of the petition of the property owners, shall be filed with the Probate Judge of Marion County, Alabama.

Section 4. The territory described in this ordinance shall become a part of the corporate limits of Hamilton, Alabama, upon publication of this ordiance as set forth in Section 3, above.
