## ORDINANCE 98003

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of March, 1998, Eric F. Barron and Lana S. Barron, being the owners of all the real property hereinafter described, did file with the City Clerk a petition asking that the said tract s or parcels of land be annexed to and become a part of the City of Hamilton; and

WHEREAS, said petition did contain the signatures of the owners of the described territory and a map of said property showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the City of Hamilton; and WHEREAS, the governing body did determine that it is in the public interest that said property be annexed to the City of Hamilton and it did further determine that all legal requirements for annexes said real property have been met pursuant to Sections 11-42-20 through 11-42-24, Code of Alabama, 1971.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The COuncil of the CIty of Hamilton, Alabama finds and declares as the legislative body of the City that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the CIty, and the citizens of the affected area, to bring the territory described in Section 2 of this ordinance into the CIty of Hamilton.

Section 2. The boundary lines of the CIty of Hamilton, Alabama, be, and the same are hereby altered or rearranged so as to include all of the territory hereto before encompassed by the corproate limits of the CIty of Hamilton, Alabama, and in addition thereto the following described territory, tr-

A tract of land lying in the W1/2 of the NW1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 9, Township 11 South, Kange 13 West, Marion COunty, Alabama, being more particularly described as: Begin at the intersection of the East boundary of the said W1/2 of NW1/4 of NW1/4, with the North right-of-way line of Marion Courty Bighway No. 42; thence Northwesterly along said right-of-way following the curvature of an 02 degrees 30 minutes curve to the left a distance of 402.8 feet (chord bearing NOrth 78 degrees 15 minutes West, chord distance of 401.9 feer) to a concrete right-of-way marker and the PC of the curve; thence continue along said North right-of-way line North 83 degrees 30 minutes West a distance of 42 feet to the East side of a gravel street; thence Northeasterly along the East side of said street a distance of 165.5 feet (chord bearing North 26 degrees 30 minutes East, Chord distance 165.0 feet); thence South 84 degrees 40 minutes East a distance of 363 feet to the East boundary of said W1/2 of NW1/4 of 15 thence South 02 degrees 00 minutes West along said East boundary a distance of 200 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published as provided by law, and a certified copy of same, together with a certified copy of the petition of the property owners, shall be filed with the Probate Judge of Marion County, Alabama.

Section 4. The territory described in the ordinance shall become a part of the corporate limits of Hamilton, Alabama, upon publication of this ordinance as set forth in Section 3, above.
