## ORDINANCE NO. 432

Ordinance No. 417 of the City of Hamilton be and hereby is repealed in its entirety and inlieu thereof:

BE IT ORDAINED that, in accordance with State law, each household in Hamilton must subscribe to a garbage pick-up service unless they have a state approved land fill. Accordingly, each houshold will henceforth receive a monthly garbage bill and failure to pay such within 15 days of due date, will result in a \$5.00 penalty, in addition to the regular bill, per day until paid in full. Anyone who feels they have a qualified land fill should being a copy of the Health Department's approval of such to City Hall.
