ORDINANCE NO. 4/19

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR A PRIVILEGE LICENSE CODE AND SCHEDULE FOR THE CITY OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I.

THAT THE LICENSE YEAR FOR THE CITY OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA, shall be from the first day of January of each year up to and including the thirty-first day of December of each such year, except as otherwise provided herein; provided that the amount of any privilege license outside the corporate limits of said city, but within the police jurisdiction thereof, shall be one-half the amount hereinafter specified.

ARTICLE II.

That the following schedule shall be, and the same is hereby declared to be, the schedule of privilege license in the City of Hamilton, Alabama, during the year 1981, and for each subsequent calendar year. Each and every person, firm, company, partnership, corporation or agent engaged in or carrying on any of the businesses, vocations, occupations, professions or callings herein shall take out, and pay for, such licenses in such sums as are herein provided before engaging in the same, except as otherwise provided herein, and shall be liable as herein provided for engaging therein without obtaining such license and shall pay a fifty cent issuance fee as set forth by the State of Alabama which is henceforth included in the privilege license schedule. Each amount for license in these articles shall be for one year unless otherwise specified.

ARTICLE III.

The adoption of this schedule of licenses shall not abridge the right of the City Council to regulate or license any business or occupation, traffic or calling not included in the foregoing schedule.

Any person, firm or corporation entering into or engaging in any business or profession in the City on or before July first of any year shall pay the full license tax for the full calendar year. Anyone entering into or engaging in any business or profession, calling or occupation, after July first of any year, shall pay one-half of the yearly privilege license herein specified.

Any person, firm or corporation dealing in two or more articles, or engaged in two or more businesses, occupations, vocations or professions for which a license is required, shall take out and pay for each such business, vocation, occupation or profession.

The annual licenses provided for herein shall be due and payable on the first day of January of each year, and shall become delinquent on and after the fifteenth day of each February and all licenses are due and payable at the Mayor's office. If business be begun after January first of any year, then the license shall be due on the date business is begun, and shall become delinquent in that event ten days from the time of date on which business is begun. On all licenses which may become on which business is begun. On all licenses which may become delinquent under the provisions hereof, there shall be due and delinquent and ditional license equal to fifteen per cent of the original license.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation or agent to engage in or carry on any of the above mentioned businesses, vocations, occupations, or professions in the City, or in the police jurisdiction thereof, without first securing and paying for the license or licenses herein provided, in which event such person, firm, corporation or agent shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon condition of such person, firm, corporation or agent shall suffer a fine of not less than \$5.00 and no more than \$100.00.

No license issued hereunder shall be in any wise a contract, but shall always be a mere grant of privilege, subject to alteration, amendment or revocation by the City Council, at its pleasure.

The City of Hamilton, through its City Council, reserves the right to change, alter, amend or revoke any license issued, at any time, or to increase or decrease the amount of the privilege license specified or set out in the license.

The schedule herein shall be for the calendar year 1981, and for each calendar year thereafter, but no license shall be issued for a longer period than one year at a time.

All licenses hereunder shall post their respective licenses in a conspicious place where the business licenses is carried on, and the holder of any such license shall be required during business hours to allow any duly authorized officer of the City to inspect the same.

The City Council shall have the right to remit any license, or portion thereof, or to exempt any person from the payment of a license hereunder, when it deems such action wise and expedient.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed, and any invalid or unconstitutional section, clause or part thereof, if any, shall not affect the validity of any valid portion of this ordinance. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
