

ORDINANCE NO. 415

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAMILTON that hereinafter a permit shall be required for the purpose of holding a yard sale, garage sale, or similar activity within the corporate limits of the City of Hamilton. Said permit shall be good for two days and each residence shall be entitled to two permits in any given month at no charge. Permits in excess of this limit may be obtained for five dollars plus fifty cents issuance fee.

Failure to obtain said permit may be punishable by a fine of no more than twenty-five dollars, nor less than one dollar.


