

ORDINANCE NO. 433

WHEREAS, an inequity existed in Ordinance 414, the Mayor and City Council of Hamilton, Alabama, hereby amend Section 15 of Article II of said ordinance to read as follows:

Billiard or game rooms, including both standard size and miniature  
pool tables of amusement games up to 10-----\$12.00 each

Game room having over 10 tables or games-----\$125.00


ADOPTED this 24th day of January, 1983.
