AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING BEING IN OR UPON A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE INTOXICATED OR DRUNK

BE IT ORDAINED BY TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, while intoxicated or drunk, to be in or upon a motor vehicle.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.
