

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA, ON AUGUST 14, 1961, APPROVED BY THE MAYOR OF SAID CITY ON AUGUST 14, 1961, ORDINANCE NO. 195 B, AND ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF PARKING METERS AND ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR THEIR USE AND OPERATION"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAMILTON ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the ordinance heretofore adopted by the City Council of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, on August 14, 1961, and approved by the Mayor on August 14, 1961, Ordinance No. 195 B, and entitled "An Ordinance providing for the installation of parking meters and establishing regulations for their use and operation", be amended by adding the following:

"Section 12 (a)". Any person who receives three (3) or more notices of parking in violation of any provision of this Ordinance and who fails to pay the penalty for such violation shall be arrested by any policeman of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, upon a warrant issued by the City Recorder which warrant shall state the time, date and place for the trial of such person for such violation by the City Recorder and if found guilty of violating this Section he shall be assessed a fine of not less than \$ 10.00 nor more than \$100.00.

"Section 12 (b)". Minimum fines for parking violations as follows:

- 1. Meter Violation ----- \$ 1.00  
If paid in 48 hours. If not paid in 48 hours the charge is ----- \$ 2.00
  - 2. Excessive Overtime ----- \$ 2.00
  - 3. Double Parking ----- \$ 2.00
  - 4. Parking in Prohibited Zone ----- \$ 2.00
  - 5. Parking At Fire Plug ----- \$ 2.00
