

ORDINANCE NO. 418

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Hamilton, Alabama, that it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to use or occupy any street within the City of Hamilton, Alabama, for the solicitation of funds, membership drives or for any purpose by establishing road blocks or otherwise stopping vehicles, causing vehicles to reduce speed or requesting the operators of such vehicles to either stop or reduce speed or in any manner interfering with the flow of traffic.

Any person or persons violating any provision of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be punished by fine not exceeding Five Hundred and No/100 (\$500.00) Dollars, and imprisoned in the City for a period not exceeding six (6) months.
