

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING LOADED BUTANE, PROPANE, AND
OTHER GASOLINE TRUCKS WHILE WITHIN THE FIRE ZONE OF
THE TOWN OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any Butane, Propane or other Gasoline truck to unload such butane, propane or other gasoline within the Fire Zone of the Town of Hamilton, Alabama, except in underground tanks.
- Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any Butane, Propane or other Gasoline truck, while loaded with any one of these Butane, Propane or Gasoline fuels, to be parked on the streets of the Town of Hamilton, its alleys, or vacant lots within the Fire Zone, except when unloading as provided in Section 1 of this Ordinance.
- Section 3. The Fire Zone shall include all business districts in the Town of Hamilton, Alabama.
- Section 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than \$5.00 or more than \$100.00 and six months hard labor.
