

ORDINANCE 2006-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA, TO EXEMPT CERTAIN "COVERED ITEMS" FROM THE MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX DURING THE FIRST FULL WEEK-END OF AUGUST, 2006, AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT 2006-574, GENERALLY REFERRED TO AS THE STATE SALES TAX HOLIDAY LEGISLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. In conformity with the provisions Act2006-574 enacted by the Alabama Legislature during the 2006 Regular Session, providing for a State Sales Tax Holiday, the City of Hamilton, Alabama exempts "covered items" from municipal sales and use tax during the same period, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the first Friday in August 2006 (August 4, 2006) and ending at twelve midnight the following Sunday (August 6, 2006).

Section 2. This ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by Act 2006-574, except that the time period shall only be as specified in Section 1 above and not for all years thereafter.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the seal of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 2006.
