

ORDINANCE NO. 428

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council (herein called "the Council") of the CITY OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA (herein called "the City") as follows:

Section 1. The Council does hereby ordain that it shall be illegal within the corporate limits of the City limits of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, or within its police jurisdiction, to attach any sign, paper, or other writing along any street or road right-of-way, to any utility pole, tree, post or other object.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation convicted of the violation of this ordinance may be fined up to a fine of \$200.00.
