AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR DISCONNECTION TO WATER LINES OF THE TOWN OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA.

Be it ordained by the Water Board of the Town of Hamilton, Alabama, a corporation in Marion County in the State of Alabama that all water customers on the water lines of the Town of Hamilton, Alabama both within the corporation limits and those who are out of the city limits pay their water bills by the 10th day of each month. All who owe water bills and do not pay bill in full will be cut off water lines until they pay water bill in full and a fee of \$5.00 will be charged to connect them back on water-lines. If the person or persons who are cut from the water line connect back to water without having paid all waterbills and a fee of \$5.00 for connection back to water lines will be fined \$25.00.

This ordinance shall go into effect on its passage and publication according to law. All ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby expressively repealed. The fore-going ordinance was published in the Marion County News, a newspaper published in Hamilton, Alabama on October 30, 1954.
