AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER AND CONVEYANCE TO THE WATER WORKS AND SEWER BOARD OF THE TOWN OF HAMILTON OF THE SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM OWNED BY THE TOWN OF HAMILTON

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Hamilton, Alabama, as follows:

(1) <u>Definitions</u>. The words "the town" as used herein mean the Town of Hamilton in the State of Alabama. The words "the board" as used herein mean The Water Works and Sewer Board of the Town of Hamilton, a public corporation existing under Act No. 175 adopted at the 1951 Regular Session of the Legislature of Alabama, as amended. The words "the sanitary sewer system" as used herein mean the entire sanitary sewer system now owned by the town, including all parts and appurtenances thereof, and all property used or acquired for use in connection therewith.

(2) Findings. The mayor and town council of the town hereby ascertain and declare that the following facts are true: the sanitary sewer system does not constitute property or any part of property used or which it is contemplated will be used by the town in the rendition of any governmental function; the town has outstanding no obligations secured by or payable from the revenues from the sanitary sewer system; it would be in the public interest and it would be advantageous to the town and its inhabitants if the sanitary sewer system should be transferred and conveyed to the board in consideration of the public benefit that will result from such transfer and conveyance. Such transfer and conveyance is authorized to be made pursuant to the provisions of Act No. 190 adopted at the 1951 Regular Session of the Legislature of Alabama.

(3) <u>Authorization of Conveyance</u>. In consideration of the public benefit that will result from such conveyance, the mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver to the board for and in the name of the town an appropriate deed whereby the sanitary sewer system shall be transferred and conveyed to the board, and the town clerk is hereby authorized to affix the corporate seal of the town and to attest the same.

(4) <u>Publication by Posting</u>. This ordinance shall be published by posting a copy thereof in each of the following three public places within the corporate limits of the town: the Mayor's office, the United States Post Office, and the Marion County Court House; and each of said copies shall remain so posted for a period of five consecutive days.
