

AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA
HELD AT THE CITY HALL
ON JUNE 11, 1973

Mayor E. T. Sims, Jr. acted as chairman of the meeting and called the meeting to order.

Upon a call of the roll the following were present: E. T. Sims, Jr., Mayor; and, Walter Haney; Floyd Long; Bobby Loden; Norman Holloway; and, Victor Cranford, Councilmen.

The Mayor announced the meeting was open for business and Councilman Walter Haney moved that the rules be suspended and asked for unanimous consent for the immediate consideration of the following ordinance.

Councilman Floyd Long seconded the motion and upon a vote being taken, those voting YEA were: E. T. Sims, Jr., Mayor; and, Walter Haney; Floyd Long; Bobby Loden; Norman Holloway; and, Victor Cranford, Councilmen.

Those voting NAY were: None.

Councilman Bobby Loden introduced the following ordinance in writing and moved for its adoption. Councilman Norman Holloway seconded the motion.

ORDINANCE NO. 388

BE IT ORDAINED By the City Council of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, that the drilling of a well for water by an individual person or persons, corporation, partnership or association below a depth of fifty (50) feet within the City limits of the City of Hamilton, Alabama, for private or personal use for any such person or persons, corporation, partnership or association is prohibited.

The violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor and a conviction for its violation shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00!

Upon a vote being taken, those in favor of adoption of the ordinance were: E. T. Sims, Jr., Mayor; and, Walter Haney; Floyd Long; Bobby Loden; Norman Holloway; and, Victor Cranford, Councilmen. Those voting against its adoption: None.

The Mayor then announced that the ordinance had been duly and legally adopted.
